## **District 23A Governor's March 19, 2012 Report to the MD Council**

### Club Visitation:

Club visits are progressing on schedule with about 15 more to be visited by year end. Some Clubs are having membership and attendance problems and they also need guidance on the types of services they provide. The Zone Chairs, Vice District Governors and some Past District Governors are working to help support and revitalize those Clubs.

### Zone Visits:

The Zones are scheduled for their third meetings this month. Previous meetings have provided a good opportunity for the various District Committees, the GMT and GLT to reach the presidents of several Clubs at one time. 23A Committee Chairs from CLERF, LCIF, and Speech and Hearing have made Zone presentations and are visiting Clubs in the District.

### District Membership:

As of March 17, District 23A membership posted a net loss of 48. Several Clubs started new member campaigns this year and are reporting new members each month. As previously reported, some Clubs are having difficulty in doing their WMMRs and Activity reports on line. Web Master Ernie Harrington and CS Keith Beaver continue to train Club Secretaries, one on one, and improvements are evident. Reports are coming in earlier and more activities being reporting.

### Leos Clubs:

In December a Danbury Leo's club chartered with 31 members. There are now three other Clubs in the development stage and should be chartered by year end.

### Looking ahead:

Clubs have been reminded to activate their nominating committees and plan for the elections of Officers in April, so that they can report their PU101s to LCI timely. We will be running a district training session in May for both new and returning Club officers.

Arbor Day is the end of April and will be time to plant the trees. We have more than 2,500 committed to date and requests for sources and guidance are still coming in
