Town residents are getting their first opportunity to vote this year and they are guaranteed that their vote will not affect their taxes, the war, or health care insurance. The Candlewood Lions are sponsoring their 9th Annual Chili Tasting Contest on Saturday, October 4th at the Senior Center in the Heritage Plaza from noon until 2 pm. This year's event will benefit the New Fairfield Food Pantry at the Senior Center.

A winner in 2007 the team of First Selectman John Hodge and Selectmen Ron Oliveri will be entering the Political Chili category featuring "Chili Italiano". Mary Ann Carson will also be entering again this year. This event has been proven to be a fun meet and greet for our community over the last several years and is always a lot of fun.

In the professional category expected to compete are last year's winner New Fairfield Food Center and Catering, Pete's Place, Shaw's and the Cook House from New Milford, additional entries from area establishments and business are expected.

Entries are still invited in three categories: Restaurants and Businesses; Political Parties and Candidates and Individuals and Groups. The entry fees for Restaurants and Political Parties is \$25.00 and for Individuals \$10.00

Entrants will provide one gallon of their chili for the tasting. The general public will act as the judges. Each entrant will be presented a medal for participating and the winners of each category will receive trophies.

Entrants will also be displaying brochures and some may share recipes.

This year the admission charge will be \$2.00 plus a canned/package food item to support the New Fairfield Food Bank. Soft drinks will be available. Entries are being solicited and will be accepted right up until the start of the tasting at 12 noon..

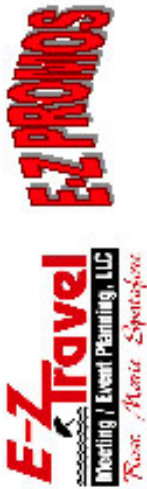

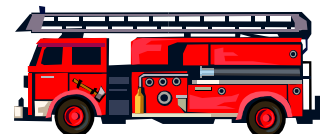
